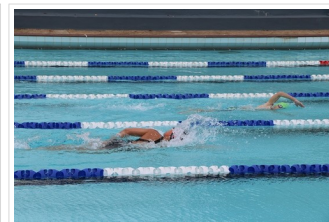
CPS SWIMMING CARNIVAL

As mentioned at Meet the Teacher:


- Schoolzine will replace Facebook and Twitter for all daily/weekly school notifications;

A REMINDER

- **Variations to pick-up** – As a duty of care, it is particularly important that parents and carers contact the office and/or your child's class teacher to authorise any variations to the normal school pick-up.
- If you are able to contribute as a **school volunteer**, please contact your child's teacher, your class parent representative or the office. If you are not already doing so, a great way to start is involvement our reinforced reading programme each morning. As part of our emergency protocols, school volunteers need to sign in and out at the office.
- As with any school, we have children with severe allergies and a range of health care needs. In order to keep all of our students safe and healthy, I ask that you:

 - remind your child not to share food at school; and
 - contact your child's teacher in advance if you are thinking about bringing in food for the class i.e. birthday celebrations (this will allow your child's teacher to put provisions in place that support the wellbeing of all our students).

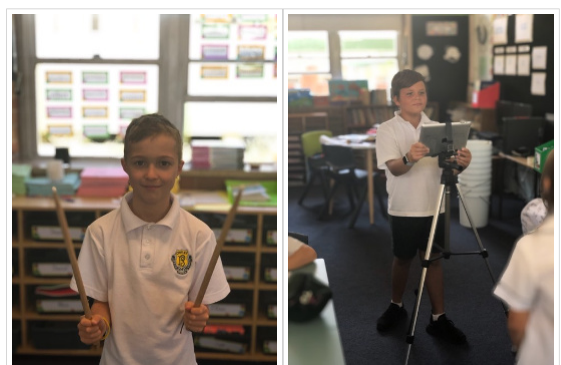


Auditions will be held between Monday 24th June to Thursday 4th July 2019.

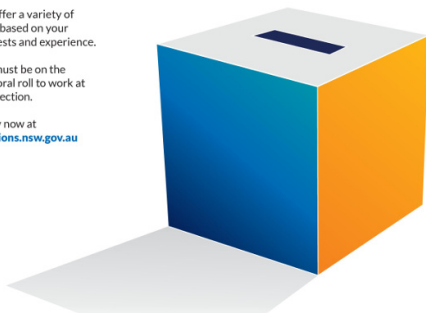

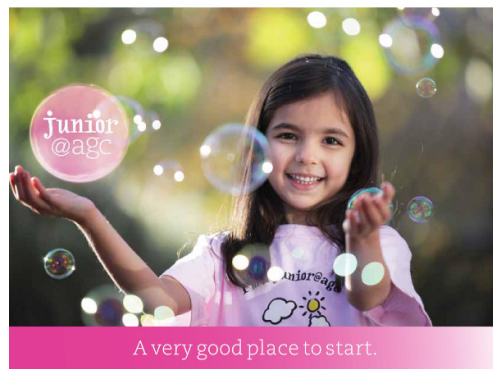
